

Haematology

Our Service

The Haematology Unit sees patients from the immediate Hunter region however some referrals are also received from outside the local area. The Unit provides a comprehensive service including:

- Bone Marrow malignancies including Acute Leukaemia, Chronic Leukaemia, Multiple Myeloma and Lymphoma
- Treatment and investigation of Bone Marrow failure states ie: Anaemia, Neutropaenia and Thrombocytopaenia
- Treatment and Diagnosis of Acquired and Inherited Bleeding and Thrombotic Disorders
- Peripheral Blood Stem Cell Transplantation.

Special features of the Unit include:

- Inpatient treatment with 8 single beds and a 4 bed area. Approximately 2 in-patients are treated in other wards.

Day Only Service

The service provides day-only transfusion, administration of antibiotics, re-assessment of recently discharged patients who require ongoing close supervision and platelet transfusion, bone marrow biopsies which require sedation and other outpatient treatments eg, lumbar punctures and IV therapy.

Apheresis service for Peripheral Blood Stem Cell Harvesting and Plasmapheresis outpatient clinics are held on a regular basis in the medical centre, now located on level three in the new Clinical Services building in Platt Street, Waratah.

Provision of a consultative service to all hospitals in the Hunter New England Health Service and also to all Hunter Area Pathology Service partners.
